Very nice for a leisurely stroll to enjoy the atmosphere.

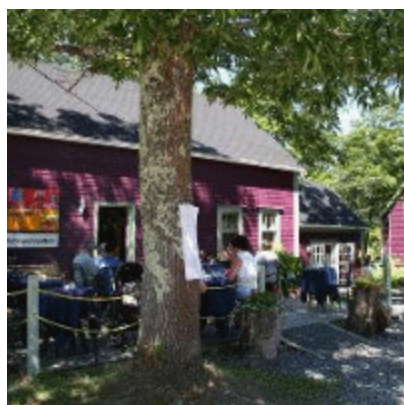
Perhaps the most famous landmarks of Mahone Bay are the three historical churches next to each other. They are in a row along Edgewater Street facing the waterfront, and they belong to the Anglican, Lutheran and United denominations.

Surrounding the town of Mahone Bay are about 100 islands which give the town a very scenic atmosphere especially on a clear and calm day. The Main Street of Mahone Bay is a lovely place to walk around as it is scattered with colourful shops selling antiques, quilts, chocolates, pottery etc, The local people invite you with open arms making your stay very pleasurable.

Mahone Bay's Settlers Museum tells you more about the immigrants to this particular area of Nova Scotia. Many people with a German background came here in the 19th century and a large map in the museum shows where the settlers to Mahone Bay came from around that time. Apart from history-explaining maps and charts you can also see several items to be found in a typical 19th century Nova Scotian household.

Directions from Halifax International Airport

1. Head north on Bell Blvd 0.8 km
2. Slight right to stay on Bell Blvd 1.5 km
3. Merge onto Hwy 102 S/NS-102 S via the ramp to Halifax/Dartmouth 23.0 km
4. Take exit 3 for 213 toward Hammonds Plains Rd/2/Bedford 0.4 km
5. Keep left at the fork, follow signs for NS-213/Hammonds Plains Rd/NS-103 72 m
6. Turn left at Hammonds Plains Rd/NS-213 15.1 km
7. Slight right to merge onto NS-103 W toward Hubbards/Yarmouth 39.4 km

8. Slight right at Hwy 103 W 16.1 km
9. Take exit 10 for Hwy 3 1.0 km
10. Turn left at HWY 3/Lighthouse Rte 2.5 km
11. Turn right at Oakland Rd 2.6 km
